For 2018 we are 100% of available meetings covered.

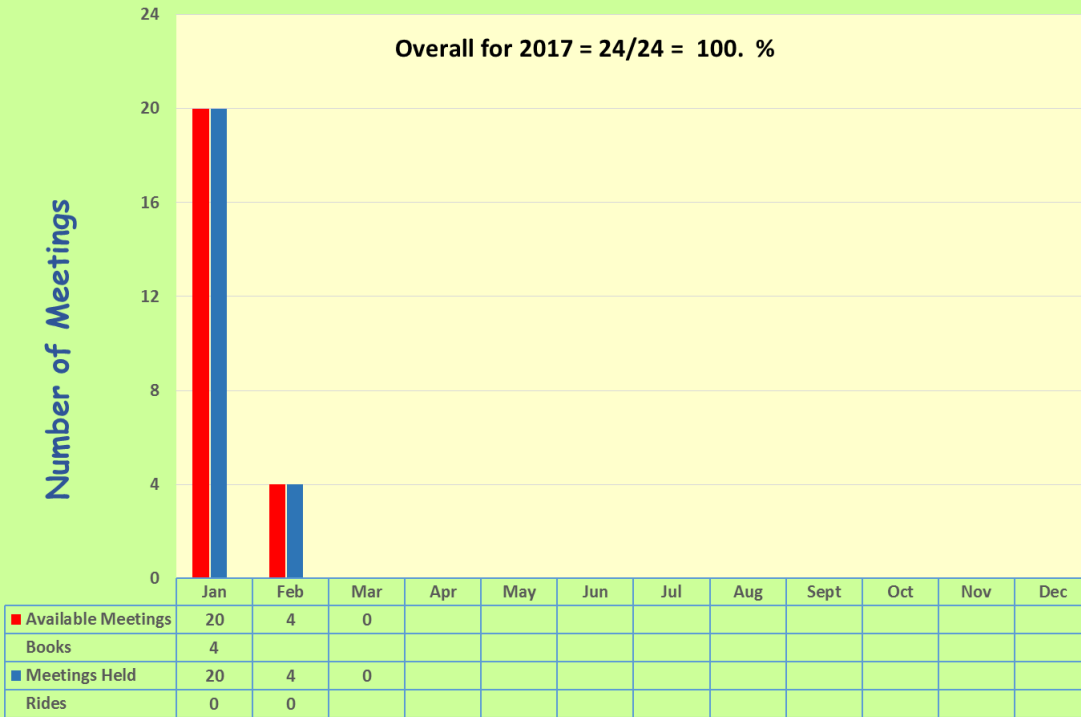
Still no one has taken advantage of the Ride to Recovery Program.
