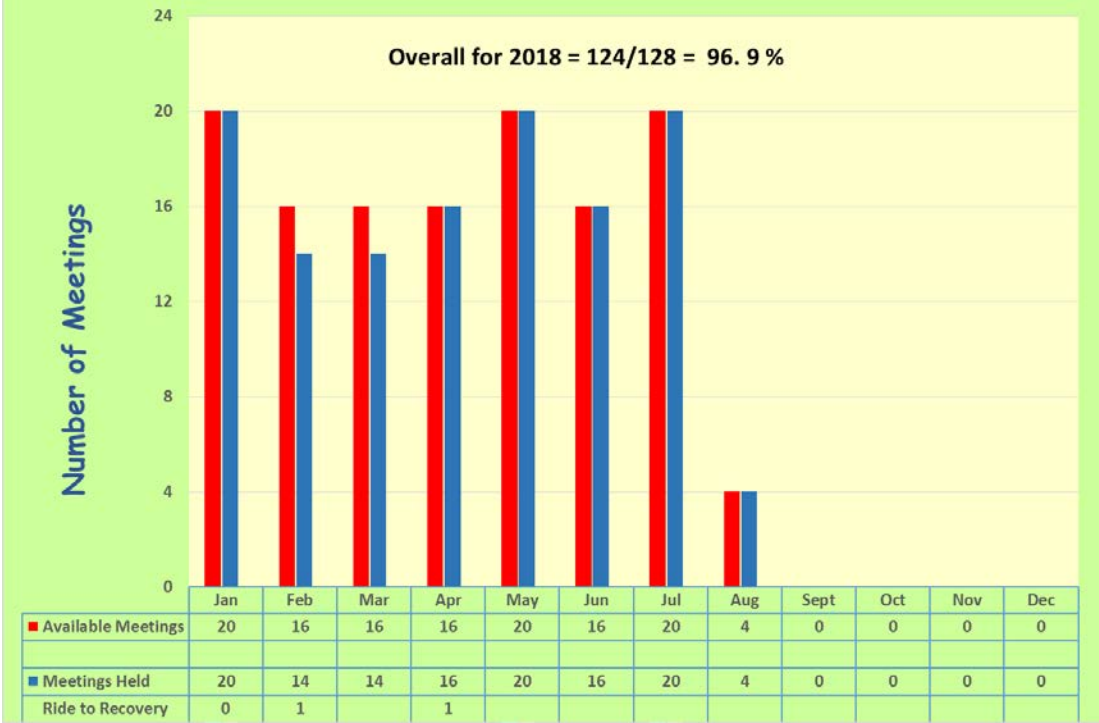
Thanks to Tim C. who dropped off a box of Literature in Madras to the Jefferson County jail Volunteers.
