Brad and I met with released inmate from OSP (Oregon State Prison in Salem) and brought him to a meeting in Prineville as part of the Inmate Prerelease Program.

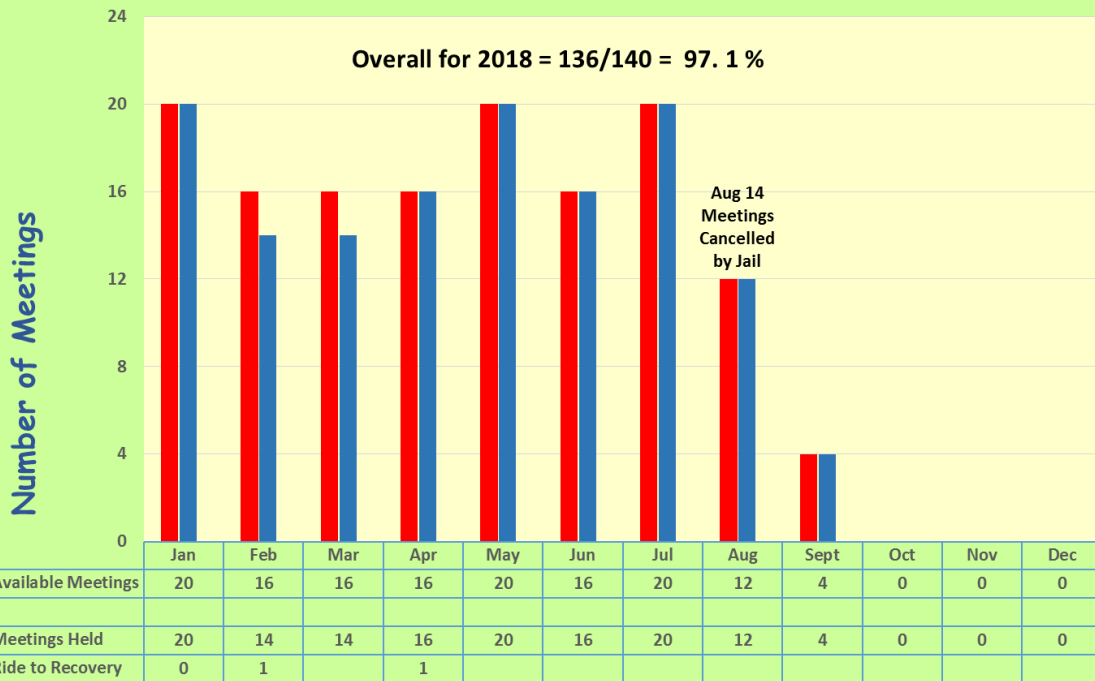
